With that said, the Executive Board continues to monitor the current mandates and guidelines set forth by the Federal, State, and local governments. With the rapidly changing situation, we find ourselves needing to adjust accordingly.

One of those adjustments is temporarily closing the Shotgun Combo field. While this was a difficult decision, it was necessary due to staff requirements at the Combo Field. At this time, the Club has limited resources and an increase in workload. This situation is due to enhanced health precautions that are required to keep the Club operational.

Currently, there are no plans to reduce any other services at the Club. The Main Public range, member ranges, and Sporting Clays Field are open with limited capacity. It is always a good idea to check the RSSC website or calendar and monitor our divisional matches to receive the most current information.

Please help us keep the community safe by:

- If you are sick, please stay home and away from others.
- Avoid handshakes or hugs. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Limit groups to less than 10 people and practice social distancing of 6 feet
