To our valued Members and Staff,

I need to begin by saying; the Executive Board, the full Board of Directors and the staff of Rio Salado Sportsman's Club are committed to protecting the health and safety of our members, employees and community. Safety has always been our top priority and because of that, the physical distancing and cleaning procedures that have become a way of life for all of us are now considered Range standards. We are closely monitoring the changing situation and will continue to comply with Public Health guidance.

As many of you know, the Governor amended the *Stay Home Stay Healthy, Stay Connected* Executive Order with Executive Order #2020-33. This Order is in effect until May 15, 2020 at which time it can be modified, extended or rescinded. It will allow certain stores previously deemed non-essential to begin offering delivery, window, walk-up, drive-thru, curbside or appointment-based service. This will take effect on May 4, 2020. Additionally, on May 8, 2020 retailers can begin offering in-store sales if they have the proper safety protocols in place, such as reducing occupancy, enforcing physical distancing requirements and expanding sanitation measures.

This Order does not affect RSSC; therefore we will not be changing any of our current health precaution policies or scheduling any future division matches. However, it does demonstrate positive movement towards the type of shooting experience we had in the past.

We have earned our reputation as one of the leading shooting facilities in the country by maintaining the safety and health of the shooters at the range. We all need to be proud of that reputation as we continue to follow the guidance provided by the Governor's office and the CDC.
