To our valued Members and Staff,

On May 4, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order #2020-34 *Building on COVID-19 Successes*. The first part of this Order takes effect May 8, 2020 and allows barbers and cosmetologists to resume operations with certain health precautions in place. The second part takes effect May 11, 2020 and will allow restaurants to resume dine in services, providing they establish and implement protocols and best practices to address COVID-19 health concerns. Based on these actions by the Governor's Office and the Arizona Department of Health Services, the Executive Board of RSSC has decided to resume portions of the Range operations previously suspended. **These operations will be effective May 15, 2020.**

Here are the minimum guidelines to allow us to resume portions of our Range operations. These guidelines are broken down into four main areas, All Shooters and Guests, Divisional matches, Shotgun Trap/Combo Field and Sporting Clays Course, and Commercial User Groups. These guidelines are closely aligned with the Governor's recent Executive Orders.

All Shooters and Guests

To the extent possible, RSSC will take measures to ensure that anyone at the Range shall follow these guidelines:

- Stay home if sick.
- Protect yourself while utilizing the Range facilities
- Stay at least 6 feet away from others while at the Range
- When you want to shoot, consider doing so during off-peak hours.
- If you are at higher risk for severe illness, avoid participating in matches or group shooting activities. People at higher risk for severe illness include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- If possible, use touchless payment (pay without touching money, a card, or a keypad). If you must handle money, a card, or use a keypad, use hand sanitizer or wash your hands with soap and water immediately after.
- After shooting at the Range, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and again when you get home.

Division Match Directors

- Maintain physical distancing, including limiting shooters on a stage to no more than 10 people, including the Safety Officer and the Scorekeeper.
- Pay special attention to limiting areas where members and guests can congregate.
- Implement comprehensive sanitation protocols.
- Consider utilizing facemasks for Safety Officers who need to be within 6 feet of the shooter to maintain required safety protocols.
- Any time a hard surface or equipment is touched by multiple people, it should be sanitized.
- Consider online pre-match registration for all shooters, thereby minimizing group contact before the match.

Shotgun Trap/Combo Field and Sporting Clays Course

- Maintain physical distancing, including limiting shooters on the field or at a station to no more than 10 people, including the Scorekeeper/Puller.
- Pay special attention to limiting areas where members and guests can congregate.
- Implement comprehensive sanitation protocols.
- Consider utilizing facemasks for anyone that need to be within 6 feet of another shooter.
- Any time a hard surface or equipment is touched by multiple people, it should be sanitized.
- Due to CDC physical distancing guidance, we will continue to suspend the following activities: 50/50/50, Registered Trap Shoots and Tuesday Pieces.

Commercial User Groups

- Maintain physical distancing, including limiting shooters in the training area to no more than 10 people, including the instructor and any assistants.
- Pay special attention to limiting areas where members and guests can congregate.
- Implement comprehensive sanitation protocols.
- Consider utilizing facemasks for instructional staff who need to be within 6 feet of the shooter to maintain required safety protocols.
- Any time a hard surface or equipment is touched by multiple people it should be sanitized.
- Consider online pre-training registration for all shooters, thereby minimizing group contact prior to the training session.

These guidelines rely heavily on the self-regulation and cooperation of our membership and guests. Currently RSSC does not have the staff or resources necessary to constantly monitor for compliance of these guidelines. As we move forward in this battle against the COVID-19 virus, it is important for us to remember that we will be successful if we look out for each other. Our Rio Salado family has proven over the last several weeks that we care about what happens to our community. Now is the time for us to continue to be leaders and demonstrate why shooters continue to be one of the most responsible members of society.

We appreciate your trust and understanding as we move through this new way of participating in the sport we enjoy. From the time you arrive at the Range, until the time you leave, our focus is and always will be the safety and wellbeing of you and our employees.
