Policy # 10 – Full-Auto Firearms

This policy is in effect because of Rio Salado Sportsman's Club's desire to foster good safety practices with regard to specialty firearms.

Procedures – Full-Auto Firearms

1. It is the policy of the Rio Salado Sportsman’s Club to allow legal fully automatic firearms to be fired, with the following exception: No fully automatic firearm may be fired by anyone who demonstrates poor control or lack of knowledge regarding the safe use of full auto firearms. No one who, in the opinion of the Range Safety Officer, lacks the physical strength to handle a full auto firearms will be allowed to fire one. The same rule applies to all firearms, but RSSC Range Officers will be particularly sensitive to questionable handling of full auto firearms. This applies to all fully-automatic firearms and extends to those that simulate by other means the firing of a fully automatic firearm. These other means include, but are not limited to, rapid firing trigger mechanisms, “bump” stocks, or any other means by which a firearm can be rapidly fired to simulate a fully automatic firearm.
2. This policy applies to all firing ranges within the Utery Mountain Shooting Range.
3. The Range Safety Officers will have the authority to determine which firearms meet this criteria.
